Tom entertained us and then chatted with members in the bar afterwards. Sadly, audience numbers were lower than expected and many of you missed a great evening.

We are proud to announce that in the recent North East Essex Theatre Guild awards the Manifest was nominated eight times. 'Oh What a Lovely War' was nominated for Best Musical, Best Technical Achievement Light/Sound, Front of House and Best Young Actor, Ryan Maslen. Other nominations were Best Supporting Actress, Gloria Streames (Humble Boy), Best Supporting Actor, John Roberts (My Friend Miss Flint) and Best Set (Humble Boy & My Friend Miss Flint). On the night we were up against some stiff competition and whilst we only won Best Set for Humble Boy, we were delighted that the Guild decided to honour Rene Hacon for her long service and dedication to the Manifest Theatre by awarding her the Jan King Trophy for Unsung Heroes.
