The plans drawn up by committee member John Roberts are now beginning to come to fruition. Local builder Jon O'Connell is carrying out the construction work on the extension to the theatre and to make your money go as far as possible, Andy Terry, your Vice Chairman and his small team of volunteers have been carrying out a good deal of the building work themselves. The footings for the building at the rear of the theatre were dug out by them, by hand.



As you can see in the picture, Taken at the AGM, the base brickwork has now been added and next Monday, the 12th August, materials are being delivered to enable us to build the rear enclosure. If you are able to help, please come along and lend a hand, Andy will need helpers all week, but especially for the Travis Perkins delivery on

the Monday morning, as the lorry might have to drop the load off outside "The Wagon" due to its size!





WE NEED YOU!

As well as the construction of the timber frame extension Andy has the following jobs for the week.

- 1) Remove the existing windows and make good frames to support new studwork.
- 2) Repair existing sofits and facias at rear of building.
- 3) Remove ceiling from backstage toilets.
- 4) Remove some slates from part of our roof to allow for new boiler flue.
- 5) Remove taps from old basins and deep clean basins and toilets for reuse.

Andy and his team will be working from 9am till 5pm (or whenever they get to a good stopping point) depending on the weather.

Jon O'Connell would also be interested if there is a member who could make a matching sash window for the front extension.
