The Dumb Waiter

By Harold Pinter

The Dumb Waiter (directed by Will) is a modernist tragicomedy written in 1957 and considered by some as the best of Pinter's early plays. It revolves around two would-be assassins, Gus and Ben, who wait in a windowless basement to learn of their next assignment. At the back of the room is a small lift (a dumbwaiter), which delivers occasional food orders. This is quite mysterious and both characters seem to be puzzled why these orders keep coming. The play is dramatic as well as absurd, as Pinter explores the idea of humanity facing a mysterious universe and an impending confrontation with mortality.
