### **Short History of the Manifest Theatre**



In 1977 a like-minded group of local people conceived the notion of a theatre group to serve the community. Dennis Murfitt, along with Val Taylor and others, decided to pursue the idea. The first meeting took place at the Waggon and Horses in Mistley. Thus, the Manifest Theatre was born.

The first venue for the Manifest productions was the Old British Legion Hall, at the top of South Street. With much enthusiasm and effort, the hall was transformed into a theatre for our first production in May 1979.

In 1984 the former Methodist primary school in Oxford Road came up for sale. Thanks to heroic fundraising the building was acquired and turned into the beautiful little theatre we enjoy so much today.

We are self-sufficient and self-supporting. Every penny we make is ploughed back into the theatre and we owe so much to our members. From our humble beginnings in 1978 of just 16 members our membership now numbers over 1200.

We are affiliated to both NODA and the NETG. Our productions are adjudicated and entered into competition with other theatre groups throughout the area. Over the years we have been nominated in almost every category and have scored wins across the board.

We pride ourselves on being inclusive, supporting members with physical and mental health issues and welcome all genders. Our objective, as stated in our Constitution is to foster and encourage live theatre in all its forms in the Manningtree area. Our auditorium holds around 85 and we have enjoyed many productions sold to capacity. Our plays and events have become an anticipated mainstay of the local calendar, pleasing and surprising those who have attended for many years and—those who have just discovered us.
